## Patch working

## **Service Changes**

As a result of the independent review some service changes have been agreed with the Local Authority and NHS Commissioners. There will be changes to the following service elements in September

#### **Drop-ins**

These are being redesigned to enable pre-school children not in a setting to access formal screening.

#### **Access and Referral**

The referral process is being revised to ensure that there is clear evidence of an identified and persistent SLCN when a child is referred-this is to enable the right children to access the service
